

## Phase out of the most toxic products - Status

Cheminova's phase-out plan includes plant protection products belonging to WHO classes Ia and Ib, i.e. products classified as "extremely hazardous" and "highly hazardous" respectively. After the plan has been accomplished such products will no longer be sold by Cheminova outside the USA, Canada, Australia, Japan and the EU.
